The regularly monthly meeting of the Chesterfield Township Board of Fire Commissioners District Two was called to order by Chairman Spence @ 8:00 PM. Members present: Bruch, Hlubik, Homa, Jones, Spence.

The sunshine law was read.

A motion to accept this slate was made by Bruch, seconded by Jones. All aye, motion carried.

Meeting Dates: April 13, 2015; May 11, 2015; June 8, 2015; July 13, 2015; August 10, 2015; September 14, 2015; October 12, 2015; November 9 , 2015; December 14, 2015; January 11, 2015; February 15, 2015; March 14, 2015 Re-organization.

A motion to approve the meeting dates was made by Bruch, seconded by Jones. All aye, motion carried. Meeting dates to be given to the clerk of Chesterfield Township, to be posted at the Municipal Building, 300 Bordentown Chesterfield Rd., Chesterfield, NJ, and advertised in the Burlington County Times.

The minutes of the previous meeting was presented. A motion to accept the minutes was made by Jones, seconded by Homa. All aye, motion carried.

Treasurers' report was presented. A motion was made by Hlubik to accept the report, seconded by Homa. All aye, motion carried. A motion to pay bills was made by Hlubik, second by Homa. All aye, motion carried.

A Cash Management Plan was introduced by Resolution 2015-3-1.

A motion to approve the resolution was made by Homa, seconded by Bruch. All aye Resolution passed.

#### Old Business:

Two quotes were received for financing the lease/ purchase of the Chief's vehicle. A Request was made to Bank of America but no response was given. PNC and Ford Credit responded, both with similar terms on total repayment. PNC required an additional down payment which made their lower rate less attractive.

A motion was made by Jones to use the Ford Credit Company to finance the lease/purchase. A second was made by Bruch. All aye, motion carried.

A Resolution to purchase the Chief's vehicle (2015-3-2) was introduced. A motion to pass the resolution was made by Jones, seconded by Homa. All aye, Resolution passed.

An EMT Agreement was presented to the Commissioners for review. The Commissioners wanted to discuss the matter further at the next meeting.

We need to get Townsend Machine to look at the breathing air compressor for possible repair.

#### New Business:

A motion to approve up to \$1500 for pagers and chargers was made by Hlubik, seconded by Jones. We need to check prices on this equipment to try and reduce cost. All aye, motion carried.

A motion to open the meeting for public comment was made by Jones, seconded by Bruch. All aye, motion carried.

Daniel Brown made a comment concerning LOSAP program suggesting some changes as to eligibility. The commissioners discussed the rules as set forth by the state to answer his questions.

A motion to close the meeting to public comment was made by Jones, seconded by Homa. All aye, motion carried.

As there was no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Jones, seconded by Bruch. All aye. Meeting adjourned @ 9:25 PM.

## Resolution 2015-3-1

### Cash Management Plan

WHEREAS, this plan is established to comply with the requirements of NJSA 40A: 5-14 and to provide a guide to officials and employees their duties concerning the receipt and disbursement of all funds of the Chesterfield Township Board of Fire Commissioners District Two, County of Burlington.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the following Cash Management Plan of the Chesterfield Township Board of Fire Commissioners District Two be and hereby is adopted:

- a. The Board of Fire Commissioners shall annually designate the depositories for all funds. This designation may be amended or supplemented from time to time as the commissioners deem necessary. Such changes shall be deemed part of the Cash Management Plan.
- b. The Fire Commissioners shall annually establish the required signatories to all bank accounts.
- c. All funds received by any official shall be deposited within 48 hours to an interest bearing account in the name of the Chesterfield Township Fire District Two, County of Burlington.
- d. The revenues received by the Treasurer shall be deposited to interest bearing accounts in the legal depositories.
- e. The following funds shall not be required to be maintained in interest bearing accounts:
  1. Change funds
  2. Petty cash funds

3. Trust funds to the extent that the deposit of such funds to an interest bearing account would require by law the payment of interest to the provider of funds.

4. Checking accounts established for the express purpose of paying bills approved by the Commissioners. The balances in these funds shall be kept at a minimum amount required for the orderly operation of the account.

5. Payroll funds.

6. Compensating balances maintained for the purpose of obtaining specific services from financial institutions.

Such accounts shall be established only under the terms of written agreements approved by the Fire Commissioners.

f. No District funds shall be disbursed by the Treasurer prior to approval of the Board of Fire Commissioners except for:

1. Debt Service payments
2. Payroll turnovers to agencies.

It shall be the responsibility of the Treasurer to analyze cash flow and to invest funds in legal investments so as to maximize interest earnings. When investing funds in commercial banks, savings and loan, etc., the Treasurer shall obtain a minimum of three quotations and shall invest at the institution offering the highest effective rate. The Treasurer shall determine which type of legal investments will best serve the needs of the Fire District and is restricted by the governing body

The Treasurer shall report annually all investment transactions as required by NJSA 40A:5-15.2 to the Board of Fire Commissioners.

## Resolution 2015-3-2

### Board of Fire Commissioners District Two

**Whereas,** The Chesterfield Board of Fire Commissioners District Two, Township of Chesterfield, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey did pass a Resolution for the purpose of purchasing fire apparatus and related appliances in an amount not to exceed \$47,000 and

**Whereas,** A special meeting was held on December 22, 2014 for the purpose of approval by the voters of Chesterfield Township in the amount of an amount not to exceed \$47,000 and

**Whereas,** The voters approved said amount and subsequently the local finance board met and approved the lease/purchase of a Chief's vehicle in an amount not to exceed \$47,000 and

**Whereas,** The voters approved the adopted budget for 2015 which included an amount which included appropriations to make payments for a Chief's vehicle,

**Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved** by the Board of Fire Commissioners, District Two of the Township of Chesterfield, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, do hereby authorize the lease/purchase of a 2015 Chevrolet Tahoe from Mall Chevrolet and financed by Ford Credit. The signatories of the Board of Fire Commissioners, either Charles Jones or Raymond Hlubik, are hereby authorized to enter into agreement with Mall Chevrolet and Ford Credit to complete this transaction.
